

6. The grant-in-aid being released is subject to the condition that  
 (a) a transparent procurement procedure in line with the Provision of General Financial Rules 2017 will be followed by the Institute/Organization under the appropriate rules of the grantee organization while procuring capital assets sanctioned for the above mentioned project and a certificate to this effect will be submitted by the Grantee organization immediately on receipt of the grant.  
 (b) While submitting Utilization Certificate & Statement of Expenditure, the organization has to ensure submission of supporting documentary evidences with regard to purchase of equipment/capital assets as per the provisions of GFR 2017.  "(Name of the Institution) agrees to make reservations for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or OBC in the posts or services under its control on the lines indicated by the Government of India". (ii) While sanctioning Grants-in-aid to Institutions or Organizations referred to in (a) above, the Grant sanctioning authority should keep in view the progress made by such Institutions or Organization in employing Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or OBC candidates in their services and also as per the GFR 2017 Rule 230(17)."
