
Filmy Solo Dance Competition







The choreography, rhythm, synchronization and presentation of all of the teams was magnificent.




The participants, throughout the entire event showed a high level of enthusiasm as well as engagement.

Finally, the resource person and participants were treated with fruit juice.



#### Report

Department of Biotechnology, Sir MVIT organized an outreach program on Awareness on Biotechnology - Experiments & Models exhibition for PUC students on 27th March 2021. A total of 24 students, 11 parents and 1 biology teacher Presidency School, Kasthurinagar took active participation in the event. The event was coordinated by 6th and 8th semester BE Biotechnology students. Preparation of all the scientific models at the different labs and demonstration of experiments was done by 6th semester BE Biotechnology students towards AICTE-VTU activity points.

A brief orientation presentation was made by 6th and 8th semester students highlighting the scope and prospects of Biotechnology. Followed by this Prof H G Nagendra, Head, Dept. of Biotechnology answered the queries by students and parents.

PUC students were divided into subgroups of 10 students each for lab tours. Even parents were interested to visit the labs as group. All the students and parents visited Bioinformatics, Microbiology, Genetic Engineering, Biochemistry, Immunotechnology, Unit operations and Process Control labs. Bioinformatics lab showed some exciting videos on communicable diseases and also the novel COVID 9 and its infection mechanism. Microbiology lab demonstrated experiments of motility, bacterial culture, gut microbiome, antibiotic sensitivity. Genetic Engineering lab showed DNA isolation and Cell division experiments, a model of recombinant DNA technology was explained and also the project on nutritional formulation was displayed. Biochemistry lab showed milk and food adulteration tests. Immunology lab demonstrated blood typing test, thin layer chromatography and wine fermentation process. All the models and experiments were demonstrated by 6th and 8th Semester students of BE-Biotechnology. Over-all coordination was done by 8th semester students and the 6th semester students prepared the scientific models and experiments demonstration.

After the visit of every lab 3 to 4 questions based quiz and feedback was collected from all the students. From parents overall feedback was collected.



He also explained the various technologies available to make develop novel products from sericulture wastes.






## Yogathon 2022- Report Summary



- At the end, QnA was there to answer the queries of the students.













# DSA Kickstart Session 2 Report






- The objective of the session was to introduce and help people develop an understanding of application programming interfaces or API's.

- Concluding the session, a small Q & A segment was kept to answer the queries of the participants.


