With reference to the above, regarding the implementation of AICTE mandatory three week Induction Programme for the students admitted to B.E./B.Tech. programmes during the academic year 2019-20, it is hereby informed that Induction Programme shall be conducted in two phases instead of conducting the same continuously for three weeks as under:

1st Phase: 11 days during the beginning of first semester 2nd Phase: 10 days during the beginning of second semester

The constituent college, affiliated and autonomous engineering colleges shall abide by the University Induction Programme guidelines in conducting the same.

The enclosed AICTE guidelines may also be referred while conducting phase wise induction Programme.

Hence, you are requested to bring this circular to the notice of all the students / faculties of your college / institution for information and to follow the same.

1st Semester BE, Three Week Induction Program (IP)

- 1. All the Managements, Principals, Faculty and Staff members of constituent, affiliated and autonomous colleges are requested to extend their whole hearted cooperation towards the successful completion of the three week IP.
- 2. As per the guidelines of AICTE, three week IP has been introduced for the $1^{\rm st}$ Semester Engineering students admitted for the academic year 2018-2019 under VTU.
- 3. This is in view of developing inquisitiveness over technical education among the stakeholders (engineering students)
- 4. IP consist of three phases namely Initial Phase, Regular Phase and Final Phase. Initial and Final Phase will have two days each and regular phase will run for 17 days
- 5. Familiarisation of procedure, scheme and syllabus, guidelines, examination system is outlined in the first phase, in addition to this, various functionary, infrastructure and facilities created by the college/institute is also outlined in the initial phase
- 6. In the regular phase in order to develop competency over physical activity, creative arts, universal human values, literary activity, proficiency modules, personality development, event management and leadership qualities, 14 day well blended schedule with grasping, speaking, writing, model making, involvement in the skill and sports activities, lecture by eminent people and visit to the local areas have been planned and record to use this data/information in future effectively.
- 7. Plenary session may be conducted in the main venue with all the stakeholders through the presentation type of activities
- 8. It is desirable to address the students in small group of 20-30 for the activity based programs for successful implementation of IP
- 9. The outcome of IP and effectiveness will be evaluated in the final phase through quiz, debate, oral and written examination. Performance in the various skills, planned events, and performance in sports and competitive spirit in the team matches are also will be evaluated.
- 10. Qualitative feedback will be collected from the stake holders for the further improvement of the IP.

- 11. The schedule of the three week is arrived based on experience, feedback and activities of the VTU and the institution. The effectiveness of the implementation of the IP depends upon the involvement of the Principal faculty, staff members and senior students of the institutions.

Fresher's Day Function, Inauguration of 1st Year Classes





The Yoga & Meditation with Light Exercises were conducted by the Yoga programme coordinatorsProf. Vijayashree (ECE) & Prof. Ramya (CV)for the sections E,F,G,H on 7-8-2019; for sections I, J, K, L on 8-8-2019; and for sections A, B, C, D on 9-8-2019. For all these sections the programme was conducted between 9am to 1pm.

This 3 days programme was about learning warm up exercises, yoga, pranayama and meditation for the physical and mental fitness of the body. All forms of exercise are important for the body. The right amount of it keeps us flexible, which reduces the joint pain and improves longevity. All forms of warm up exercises, cardio exercises and Surya Namaskar or Sun salutation were taught. Surya Namaskara is a gesture of showing gratitude to the Sun. It is a set of 12 yoga asanas which brings body, breath and mind together and keeps the body flexible. Next, the trainers concentrated on various Yogasanas. Yogasana improves flexibility, muscle strength, healthy respiration and maintains a balanced metabolism.

After Yogasana session, Pranayama and meditation session was arranged. 'Prana' means 'Breath' and 'Ayama' means 'Control' so it is called as Pranayama. Pranayama is the perfect breathing exercise which increases the positive energy level in the body and removes toxins. Pranayama (breathing exercises) supplies more oxygen to the body. Pranayama is the key to a healthy body and mind. Those who practices it regularly, will feel very energetic throughout the day.

The feedback received from the participants was very good. Thus, this 3 days programme was conducted very successfully.




Fig: Doctors Motivation towards blood donation held on 27-02-2020 all around the campus. They explained what are the Dos and DONTs to donate the blood.




Fig: Registration by different Blood Banks before the Blood donation












Fig: 1st year BE students participation in Swacch MVIT Abhiyan Program.




