



Department of Biotechnology, Sir MVIT organized a one day outreach program on “Hands on training of basic biology experiments to school teachers” on 11th May 2019. There were 20 teachers and instructors associated with M/s Agasthya Foundation have participated in the event. Agasthya International Foundation is an Indian education trust and non-profit organization based in Bangalore, India whose mission is to spark curiosity, nurture creativity and build confidence among economically disadvantaged children and teachers in India. All these teachers have come from all regions of Karnataka representing many districts. Mr Suresh T S and Mr Dileep authorities from Agasthya Foundation have accompanied the teachers.


Prof H G Nagendra, HOD, Dept. of BT, Sir MVIT welcomed all the participants to the event and also gave a formal introduction of the training program and the faculty coordinators involved in the activities. There were a set of 26 experiments planned to train these teachers from four of the laboratories, namely, Microbiology lab, Biochemistry lab, Molecular Biology lab and the Aspartika Lab.

The 20 teachers were split into two groups of 10 each for the laboratory sessions. Morning Microbiology and Molecular Biology labs conducted the training of experiments. The experiments at the Aspartika Labs were coordinated by Mr Shrinivas BV, Ms Deepa HN, Mr Amish Noah and other research scholars.



In conclusion the event was very successful. Both the participants and the coordinators from MVIT BT department and Agasthya Foundation felt very satisfied being the part of this training activity.





**Report on one day “Awareness program on Rabies control and management” conducted on 5th April
2019 to commemorate World Health Day 7th April 2019**

Department of Biotechnology, Sir MVIT has organized a one day “Awareness program on Rabies control and management” on 5th April 2019 to commemorate World Health Day 7th April 2019 in association with Dr. Shampur Madhusudana Trust & Foundation for Neglected Disease Research (FNDR). Dr. Shampur Madhusudana Trust which is founded by Girija Madhusudana in memory of her husband Late Dr. Shampur Madhusudana who was a renowned scientist of international repute in Rabies research. This trust is actively involved in creating awareness on Rabies control and management with a vision of Rabies free India. Foundation for Neglected Disease Research (FNDR) is a research body housed at Sir MVIT incubation centre is actively involved in neglected disease research like Rabies.

The first half of the event was an outreach activity to the nearby Sir MV Government Primary School at Hunsamaranahalli. Around 200 school kids belonging to 4th to 8th standard participated in the event. Dr. Chridhar Narayana, CEO, FNDR welcomed everyone and introduced the guests. Dr Chandrashekhar from Dr. Shampur Madhusudana Trust gave introduction of the event and showed a video on the implications of Rabies to the students. After Dr Someshwara’s session a pledge as taken by all the participants on eradicating Rabies from our community. The event organizers thanked the school for giving the opportunity to communicate to the students.



On a whole the event was very fruitful in creating awareness among the community on the Rabies control and management.




