❖ DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT COORDINATORS

> The duties and responsibilities of the department coordinators include:

- 1. To implement the rules and regulations as per the disciplinary rules.
- 2. To make the student aware of the discipline rules/code of conducts and strictly adhere to them.
- 3. To initiate disciplinary action against any of the misconduct.
- 4. To coordinate with disciplinary committee in case of any disciplinary activity.
- 5. To report the cases of indiscipline to the committee on case to case basis.
- 6. The department disciplinary committee coordinators are responsible for the overall discipline of the students of their department.

❖ DISCIPLINE RULES/ CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

A) PREAMBLE

This discipline rules / Code of conduct indicate the standard procedures and practices of the Sir M. Visvesvaraya Institute of Technology for all students enrolling with the Institute for pursuing varied courses. All students must know that it is incumbent upon them to abide by this Code of Ethics and Conduct and the rights, responsibilities including the restrictions flowing from it. That the Institute's endeavor by means of enforcing this Code is to pioneer and administer a student discipline process that is egalitarian, conscientious, effectual and expeditious; and providing a system which promotes student growth through individual and collective responsibility. All Students are requested to be well conversant with this Code, which can be also reviewed on the official website of the Institute.

B) JURISDICTION

The Institute shall have the jurisdiction over the conduct of the students associated /enrolled with the Institute and to take cognizance of all acts of misconduct including incidents of ragging or otherwise which are taking place on the Institute campus or in connection with the Institute related activities and functions.

Institute may also exercise jurisdiction over conduct which occurs off-campus violating the ideal student conduct and discipline as laid down in this Policy and other regulations, as if the conduct has occurred on campus, which has a negative impact or constitutes a nuisance to members of the surrounding off-campus community. The Institute, while determining whether or not to exercise such off-campus jurisdiction in situations enumerated hereinabove, the Institute shall consider the seriousness of the alleged offense, the risk of harm involved, whether the victim(s) are members of the campus community and/or whether the off campus conduct is part of a series of actions, which occurred both on, and off-campus.

C) ETHICS AND CODE:

- 1. The students should strictly follow the rules and regulations of the college.
- 2. Students shall wear the Institute identity (ID) card always on the campus, during the tests and examinations. In case of loss of the Identity Card, the student should report it to the authorities concerned and should immediately collect a duplicate ID Card. Students without ID Cards are not allowed to enter the college campus. ID card must be produced whenever asked for by any of the college authorities.
- 3. Students shall wear clean, neat and presentable clothing.
- 4. Every student is expected to have a minimum attendance of 85% as prescribed by the University for qualifying to take university semester examinations.
- 5. As a Sir MVITian, every student should maintain high standards of discipline, courtesy and behavior both on and off the campus.
- 6. Students are expected to behave politely and in courteous manner towards the staff.
- 7. Students are strictly forbidden from consuming drugs. Smoking, consuming alcohol inside the campus is strictly prohibited. Those who indulge in such activities will attract disciplinary action such as suspension/expulsion from the institute.
- 8. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. If any information is received about any student involved in any form of ragging, he/she will be called for an enquiry and suitable action will be taken such as fine/suspension/expulsion from the institute.
- 9. As per the direction from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and relevant instructions from the University & UGC authorities, Anti-Ragging Committee is formed in this

- College. All the students are encouraged to approach them without any hesitation in case of ragging.
- 10. Indulging or supporting malpractice and misbehavior will be considered undesirable and will be viewed seriously. Suitable action will be taken as per the institution norms.
- 11. During the class hours, students are forbidden from loitering along the corridors or roads. Students are required to spend their free hours in the library.
- 12. Students shall strictly observe and follow the safety regulations in the laboratories and workshops.
- 13. Care should be exercised in handling the property of the institute and any damage caused casually or willingly will entail disciplinary/penal action and recovery of cost.
- 14. Students are prohibited from damaging any asset of the institute. Students are forbidden from writing or marking on the walls or desks. The cost of any damage so caused will be recovered along with fine from the students concerned or collectively, if responsibility for it cannot be fixed on any individual. Besides the fine, they will also be subjected to disciplinary action.
- 15. A disciplinary committee constituted by the institute will manage the students' discipline efficiently and effectively. The committee can summon any student(s) to appear before them in relations to an enquiry into any issue related to student discipline. Also, based on the severity of the issues, parents will also be called during the enquiry.
- 16. Students are required to give an undertaking at the time of joining the institute to abstain from ragging, eve-teasing, smoking, use of alcoholic drinks, drugs and indulging in any other undesirable activity.
- 17. Students should strictly desist from use of rude language towards staff of the institute/hostel, assaulting or attempting to assault the staff or fellow students of the institute.
- 18. Students are advised to actively participate in all the functions and meetings held in the institute. The institute will provide them an opportunity to participate in cultural and technical events as well as sports.
- 19. Principal/hostel authorities have the power to frame and issue additional/amended rules and regulations for proper conduct of proceedings inside and outside the institute and/or hostel premises from time to time.

- 20. Students should approach their Local Guardians/Class advisers/Head of the department concerned for any requests, complaints or any requirements, not directly to the higher authorities.
- 21. In all academic or disciplinary matters, decision of the authorities of the institute shall be final.
- 22. Students should keep the campus clean and should use the waste bins to dispose the waste materials.
- 23. Playing games/ partying /personal celebrations and thereby disturbing the college environment is strictly prohibited.
- 24. Riding bikes without helmet, with more than one pillion riders, over speeding, wheeling in the campus are strictly prohibited.
- 25. Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the academic areas. Mobile phones of students, not adhering to this rule, will be confiscated by college authorities
- 26. Physical intimidation of other students and staff, indulging in criminal acts of any kind are strictly prohibited.
- 27. No student in whatsoever manner will create/publish/comment/or do any such act/s on any social media against the interest of the institution or its members (Teaching, Non-Teaching Staff, Students and other such members), and if found doing / abetting such acts will liable for his/her misconduct under appropriate laws and the prevailing cyber law.
- 28. Students shall not invite or encourage outsiders to enter the campus without any proper reason and without permission from the Institute.
- 29. Sexual harassment will be viewed very seriously.
- 30. No student should take the law into his/her own hands, whatever the circumstances may be. Use of violence by a student on any other person will be viewed seriously and dealt with severely. If students need any help, they can approach disciplinary coordinators of the department.
- 31. Students should not participate in any political and antisocial activities on campus.

D) DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

If there is a case against a student for a possible breach of code of conduct, then Disciplinary committee shall inquire into the alleged violation and accordingly suggest the action to be taken against the said student. The committee may meet with the student to ascertain the

misconduct and suggest one or more of the following disciplinary actions based on the nature of misconduct.

- 1 WARNING- Indicating that the action of the said delinquent student was in violation of the Code and any further acts of misconduct shall result in severe disciplinary action.
- 2 RESTRICTIONS -Reprimanding and restricting access to various facilities on the campus for a specified period of time.
- 3. MONETARY PENALTY- May also include suspension or forfeiture of scholarship/fellowship for a specific time period.
- 4. SUSPENSION- A student may be suspended for a specified period of time which will entail prohibition on participating in student related activities, classes, programs etc. Additionally, the student will be forbidden to use various Institute facilities unless permission is obtained from the Competent Authority.
- 5. EXPULSION Expulsion of a student from the Institute permanently. Indicating prohibition from entering the Institute premises or participating in any student related activities or campus residences etc.

If a student doesn't have an identity card, he/she has to make arrangements to obtain it immediately through the HOD/office.

(It is the responsibility of the HOD and the faculty members of the department to ensure that the students of their department attend the class with identity card.)

Mobile Phones: Mobile phones should not be used in academic areas such as classrooms, labs, workshops, library and office. But normally all students possess mobile phones.

It is the responsibility of the class teacher to ensure that students should switch off their mobiles/silent mode and keep them in their bags away from them during classes (theory/Practical). If still students violate the norms and misuse the mobiles inside the learning centre, it may be reported to the disciplinary committee through Principal.

The disciplinary committee suggests providing the committee members the power to visit the classrooms/labs/workshops/library on **random** basis to check the students' ID, mobile. This will create alertness in the minds of students as well as faculty. If any student is found without ID or possessing

mobile, he/she will be enquired and suitable action will be taken by the committee.

- 3. University Examination/Class Tests: It shall be the responsibility of Exam Supervisors to report in writing any malpractice or anomaly found during the examination to the Principal. The Principal in turn shall hand over the matter to the Committee.
- 4. Loitering during Classes: During class hours, students are forbidden from loitering along the corridors or disturb other classes at work. Any violation will be viewed seriously. (The senior faculty members and HOD of the department can monitor their department). If it happens regularly, it may be reported to the disciplinary committee through proper channel.
- 5. **Disciplinary Action:** Based on the severity of the incident, disciplinary action on students will include any one or more of the following as decided by the Disciplinary Committee:
 - a. Fine
 - b. Suspension from attending the classes for a specific number of days. Such suspension period will be treated as days of absence.
 - Expulsion from the Institute/Hostel (depends on the severity of the matter)
- 6. In all disciplinary matters, decision of the committee members shall be final.
- 7. No notice of any kind shall be circulated/ pasted on the notice boards regarding the disciplinary enquiries/actions of the institute.
