Sub: Anti Ragging committee report in response to your email dt. 16.02.21

Ref. No. ARCC/KA-6533

In response to your above referred email, the Anti Ragging committee conducted a meeting chaired by it's coordinator, Dr. K. Shanmukharadhya (HOD ME) on 17.02.21 and the following course of action was taken with regard to the said complaint.

- 1. The Principal addressed all the 1st year students residing in Boys' Hostel in the CSE Seminar Hall at 3 p.m. and inquired if any student was facing problems in the hostel, especially related to issues such as ragging. No student complained about any such thing. However, the Principal advised the students to keep the mobile numbers of Anti ragging committee members, their department HODs and their Faculty Local Guardian and to immediately inform them for assistance in case of any problem or senior students calling them to their rooms.
- 2. Since a separate block (Unit-1) has been provided for 1st year students all security personal has been deployed to safe guard the students and to prevent any senior students from entering inside.
- 3. The Anti Ragging committee members visited the Hostel (Unit-1) in the evening and spoke to all the 1st year students to instill confidence in them and also advised them not to entertain any senior students invite to other Blocks and to immediately call any of the Anti-Ragging committee members and they will receive assistance immediately.
- 4. The committee also visited Unit-5 which has been named in the complaint and warned all the senior dents to desist from any acts of ragging and if found guilty such students will be booked under Anti Ragging Laws.
- 5. The committee also decided that the Anti Ragging Flying Squad must visit the Hostel Unit-1 every day in the evening and to closely monitor and keep in touch with the 1st year students to ensure no incident of Ragging takes place.
- 6. The Boys' Hostel Warden and security staff have been directed to keep special watch on 1st year students and ensure their safety.

The Anti-Ragging committee Report along with necessary supporting documents and video clippings are enclosed in the attached file.

Finally, I wish to state that, our college is taking all necessary steps to prevent any form of ragging in our campus including Hostels and to maintain a Ragging free atmosphere.

We have received a complaint of ragging from a student of **Sir M. Visvesvaraya Institute of Technology**. You are requested to identify & counsel the victim so that he feels safe and knows that authorities are with him & action will be taken on his complaint. You are also requested not to disclose the identity of the victim. The details are given below.

"7.1 Action to be taken by the Head of the institution by the order of Hon. Supreme Court:

on receipt of any information concerningany reported incident of ragging, the Head of institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following, namely;

- v. Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- vi. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- x. Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences;
- xi. Extortion;

xvii. Physical or psychological humiliation;

NOTE: Enquiry /Investigation /Disciplinary Committee reports etc. are not acceptable. As per UGC regulations only report of the Anti Ragging Committee is acceptable.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING HELD ON 17.02.2021

As per the direction of the Principal, Anti-ragging Committee meeting was conducted on 17.02.2021 at 2 pm at Mechanical Engineering block. Members of the committee attended the meeting. Following are the points discussed:

- The anti-ragging committee of Sir MVIT comprising of all senior professors, hostel wardens' local police officers and flying squad teams are functioning effectively.
- The Flying squad team members are reporting their observations regularly, in the register maintained at hostels and college, every day.
- Anti-ragging Committee has taken steps and allotted duties to all the staff members at almost all areas in the college (i.e. canteen, parking places, different academic blocks, hostels, play grounds, ATM, Xerox shops etc.)
- The anti-ragging committee considers the complaints received from the students and conduct enquiry and submit report to the Principal along with punishment recommended for the offenders. The disciplinary action will be conducted in line with the UGC guidelines.
- Anti-ragging Committee has taken precautions to avoid ragging activities at other locations like bus stops and given instructions to faculty members for careful observation at various boarding points.
- Key contact details of the senior professors have been displayed in the campus and hostels for students' information and to contact at any time.
- After the meeting, Dr V R Manjunath, Principal, addressed all the first year students at CSE seminar hall at 3 pm and enquired about any incidence of ragging in the hostel. There was no reply from any of the students.

- Later Principal suggested the Anti-Ragging Committee members to visit and enquire the first year students, who are accommodated at UNIT 1 of the Men's hostels. The committee visited and interacted with the students at 5.30 PM on 17.02.2021. No students reported about the incidence of ragging.
- The Coordinator and the members of the committee visited all the rooms in UNIT 5, where senior students are accommodated. It was completely under control and there was no movement of students from one unit to another unit. It is strictly managed by the hostel authorities.

There are volunteers from FIRST year who have regular contact with the Coordinator and members of the Anti-Ragging Committee. The situation is completely under control and students are comfortable.

With reference to the above, a detailed investigation was conducted by the following committee members on 16.01.2021 from 5.30 PM to 7.30 PM at Sir MVIT Ladies Hostel Office.

- Dr K S Shanmukharadhya, Coordinator, Anti-Ragging Committee, Sir MVIT, Bengaluru.
- Dr V Shantha, Warden, Ladies Hostel and Member of Anti-Ragging Committee, Sir MVIT.
- Mr T R Nagesh, Assistant Sub Inspector of Police, Chikkajala Police Station, Bengaluru and two more representatives from the Police Department, including a Lady Constable.
- The investigation committee called all the students and interacted with them. Firstly, the five students, who had interacted with Arjita (ISE), Pranjal (CSE) and Jahnvi (Biotech) on 14.01.2021 were called and inquired. All the students reported that there was no ragging and it was only a friendly discussion.

- Later the three students by name with Arjita (ISE), Pranjal (CSE) and Jahnvi (Biotech) were called by the committee members and inquired. The interaction which they had with all the five students on 14.01.2021 was not different.
- It was the same reply from all the five students also.




Fig 3. From L to R: Jahnvi(Biotech), Arjita (ISE) and Pranjal(CSE)

ICC regularly organizes a programme to create awareness about "Sexual harassment-Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal acts" for all students.

Apart from the above, ICC organizes motivational talk on topics like "Role of Women in Armed Forces" and awareness programme on women hygiene etc,.

2. COMPLAINT AND REDRESSAL MECHANISM OF ICC

- 1. Receipt of the complaint from the student who has been subject to Sexual Harassment.
- 2. Acknowledge the receipt of complaint.
- Committee organizes a meeting and talk to the complainant to discuss options of Informal/formal resolution
- 3. Start Informal/formal mechanism of redressal as chosen by the complainant.
- 4. Plan carefully and prepare the file.
- 5. Assess completeness of the information collected.
- 6. Analyse information gathered. Compare similarities/differences of statements.
- 7. Conclude whether the complaint is upheld or not and recommendations according to findings.
- 8. Writing the report and submitting to Principal for further action.

3. REPORT ON REDRESSED

The number of grievances redressed is nil since no written complaints are received from students in this regard from the year 2019 to 2023.
