Suggestions by IQAC Memebhrs	Action
The Academic Chairman suggested holding a competition for designing a logo for IQAC.	An IQAC logo competition was held, and the faculty member who designed the logo was felicitated with a cash prize of ₹5,000/-
The members suggested reframing the Vision and Mission statements based on NBA and NAAC team recommendations.	The vision and mission reframing process has been initiated following the procedures laid out by the NBA and NAAC. Feedback from all stakeholders was obtained, and the new Vision and Mission statements were framed. Further feedback on these statements has also been obtained from all stakeholders.
The members suggested applying for funding from government and private agencies.	Sir MVIT has received approval for an FDP proposal under the "VAANI" scheme by AICTE. The institute has been granted ₹2,00,000/- to conduct this FDP.
Dr. Mahesh suggested signing new MoUs with reputed companies.	New MoUs have been signed between Sir MVIT and several reputed industries.
	Feedback on the curriculum and infrastructure has been reframed and sent to the Criteria-1 Coordinator.
The IQAC members suggested having external auditors for the academic audit.	As suggested by an external member in the IQAC meeting, an academic audit was conducted with three external auditors. These auditors, along with senior faculty members of Sir MVIT, audited the departments and submitted reports. The departments have since submitted their action plans to address the observations made during the audit.

Dr. Mahesh emphasized the quality of publications.	As per his suggestion, the faculty are encouraged to publish in only the reputed journals. The faculty are given incentives for publishing their research in reputed journals and conferences.
One member suggested conducting a workshop on quality research.	In response, a Faculty Development Program on Quality Research Publications was conducted, resulting in significant growth in the quality of paper publications in recent times.
The suggestion for applying for the AICTE Idea lab	Based on a suggestion from one of the members, the institute applied for the AICTE Idea Lab. Dr. Prashanth H. and Dr. Mahesh K. served as coordinators for this initiative, and the results are awaited.
Ms.Sahana recommended that the faculty and students can pursue certification programs from Infosys Spring Board	As recommended by Ms. Sahana, both faculty and students are actively pursuing certification programs.
