Rules & Regulations

Participants will work perpetually over 24 hours on innovative projects across the following domains:



1 Participation Requirements

Eligibility : Open to students currently enrolled in accredited educational institutions.

Team Size : Teams must consist of 3 to 4 members.

Registration : All team members must complete registration through the official registration links only.

Registration fee : INR 300-/- Per Head

Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.

2 Idea Submission

- Teams are required to submit their project ideas by the specified deadline.
- Projects must align with one of the hackathon's domains.
- Ensure that you follow the guidelines provided by the application used for conducting the hackathon.
- Evaluation Criteria: Projects will be judged based on creativity, technical feasibility, impact in the society and presentation.

3 Hackathon Structure

- An inauguration ceremony will take place before the commencement of the hackathon.
- Upon conclusion of the 24 hours, teams are required to present their working model, wherein each team will be allotted 10 minutes for their presentation.

Rules & Regulations



- Teams can work continuously on-site throughout the event, with access to mentors, industry experts, and necessary resources.

4) Code of Conduct

- Participants are advised to bring essential items, including bedsheets, pillows, water bottles and any personal medications.
- Strict action will be taken against any misconduct, including drug use sexual harassment, vulgarity, intimidation, inappropriate disruption, discrimination, or bringing any items that may pose a threat to others.
- Derogatory language, threats, or intimidation will not be tolerated.
- Recording without consent is prohibited (e.g., photographing, video, or audio recording of presentations without the presenter's permission)
- Participants must respect copyrights—no plagiarism or reuse of past work will be allowed.
- Any violation of these rules will lead to immediate disqualification from the hackathon.
- Respect and Professionalism: Participants are expected to respect all and accept constructive feedback gracefully.
- Participants should report any violations of the rules to event organizers or staff immediately.
- Zero tolerance is maintained for misconduct, and all reports will be handled confidentially and with utmost seriousness.
- Designated organizing team members will be available throughout the event to ensure a safe and respectful environment.

- Participants will have access to internet resources at the venue.
- Participants are allowed to make use of LLMs for programming help.
- Personal equipment, including laptops, chargers, extension cords, power banks, and any additional tools or devices necessary for project development, must be brought by participants.
- Participants are responsible for safeguarding their belongings throughout the event, as the organizers will not be liable for any lost or damaged items.

6 Prizes

- The total prize pool is ₹1 Lakh+ and + \$500 partner prize pool.

7 Mentorship and Workshops

- Throughout the event, mentors will be available to guide in the respective domains.

- Teams must present their final projects to a panel of judges for evaluation.


